A piece of land surrounded by water.

A large body of saltwater partially enclosed by land.

A long, flowing body of water, usually freshwater.

Water flowing vertically down a steep drop in a river or stream.

A very large natural rocky landform.

A dry and sandy area with little rainfall and sparse vegetation.

A large and densely populated area with many buildings, infrastructure, and services.

A vast body of saltwater that covers most of the Earth's surface.

Elevated areas of land that are lower than mountains with rounded slopes.

A wide, open area of grassland without many trees.

A large body of water surrounded by land.

Sandy or pebbly area next to a body of water.

A large area covered with trees growing closely together.

A big area of land with lots of open fields, farms, forests, and beautiful nature. It's usually far away from cities and towns.

A small, narrow flowing body of water, typically freshwater, that is smaller than a river.

A place with green spaces, playgrounds, and places to relax.
